



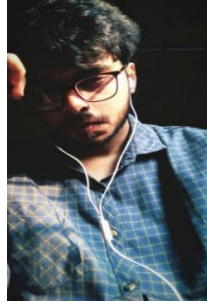

October 9: The Ranking Committee of VU headed by the CIR director met again and made several recommendations. The committee discussed the possibility of establishing several units across the campus. We are excited to notice that many of them will be operated under the umbrella of the Career Center. Here is the list of a few of these programs.

- Establish a 'Learning Center' operated by TA's at the main/Kazla campus.
- Rename 'Information' Desk at Kazla campus as 'Information Center' and open a 'CareerOneStop' corner inside the Information Center at Kazla campus.
- Establish a 'Job Placement Office' adjacent to the Career Center office at Kazla campus.
- Open a 'Mental Health Support Center' at the ground floor of Kazla campus under the guidance of the Department of Public Health.
- Reinstate the non-functional Aroggo Niketon as a Community Health Care Center at the ground floor of Kazla campus.
- Establish a 'Public Lecture Room' at the ground floor of Kazla Campus.
- Allot an office for the Cultural Club at the ground/first floor of Kazla Campus.
- Convert the existing VU Library located on the first floor of Kazla Campus in to a 'Public Library'. Equip it with attractive materials.
- Convert some office rooms to 'Quiet Room' and 'Group Discussion Room' adjacent to the library.
- Convert the existing Computer Lab located on the first floor of Kazla Campus in to a Public Computing Lab and make it open for all in terms of getting access to the digital literacy and other training programs.
- Establish a 'Writing Center' at the ground/first floor of Kazla Campus and make it accessible to all.
- Establish a 'Day Care Center' for the kids in the main campus. It may be operated by a private organization.
- Create a 'Breast Feeding Corner' inside the Female Common Room located at the ground floor of the Academic Building in the main campus.

October 23 – 24: The American Corner Rajshahi arranged an Info Session and Mini Pop-Up Event. at the American Corner Rajshahi. This event was designed to provide valuable insights into the

resources available at American Spaces, as well as engage students in interactive activities that showcase American culture and education. During the Info Session, attendees learned about various programs and resources offered at American Spaces, including educational materials, cultural exchanges, and opportunities for collaboration. The Mini Pop-Up featured engaging activities, including workshops and demonstrations that highlighted the richness of American culture, exchange programs opportunity for the students as well as teachers. This event enriched experience for your students, fostering curiosity and enhancing their understanding of American values and education.
