November 11: The Ranking Committee of VU successfully submitted data to Times Higher Ranking website.

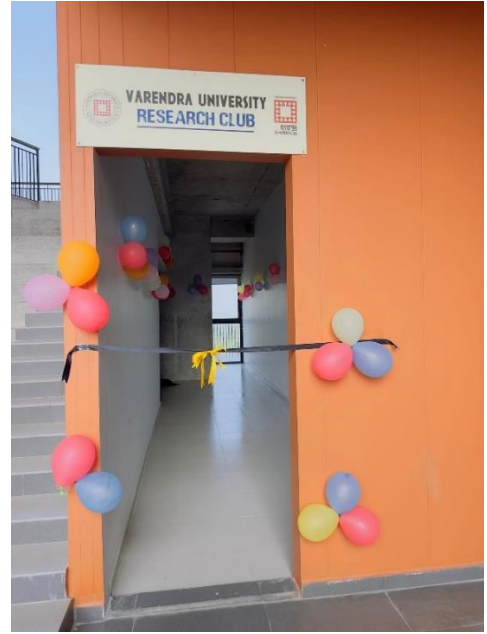
